AT-RISK HOMELESS Behind on rent or utility payments. Considered Imminent Risk if residence will be lost within 14 days. PREVENTION **CRISIS RESPONSE** Rental & Utility Assistance Diversion Legal Guidance • Emergency Case Management

Lacks a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence or is fleeing/attempting to flee domestic violence.
